

Winterizing an Outdoor Sink

An outdoor kitchen sink is similar to an outdoor hose bib and must be properly winterized prior to freezing temperatures. Failure to follow these steps may result in frozen lines which are not covered under warranty.

1. Turn off the water at the source in the furnace room.
2. Open the bleeder valve caps (1-hot and 1-cold).
3. Open the outdoor kitchen faucet so the water can drain.
4. Pour 8 oz. of non-toxic anti-freeze into the drain to prevent any remaining water from freezing.

Additionally, it is recommended that sinks are covered to prevent debris from collecting in the basin.
